Pack Fall Recruitment Steps

Ensure each family is invited into Cub Scouts

Before August:

- 1. Develop a Pack calendar with specific dates and activities for the next school year.
- 2. Pack Identifies a New Member Coordinator or volunteer to head recruitment.
- 3. Attend recruitment training, provided by the council or district.
- Review list of marketing ideas and determine plan. Collect and review marketing materials provided by the Council. Includes: yard signs, flyers, stickers, bookmarks, buddy cards, and more
- 5. Share recruitment plans with District Executive.
- 6. Contact School regarding orientation night at the school and recruitment nights.
- 7. Update BeAScout Pin

August:

- 8. Be at School's Open House/Orientation Night/Back to School
 - a. Find volunteers to help with a booth
 - b. Have activities to promote recruitment
 - c. Be ready to have Cub Scouts join.
- 9. Find places in advance for yard signs or other promotional information to be placed.
- 10. Plan School visits, assemblies, lunch rooms, eating with your Scout in uniform to promote recruitment event.
- 11. First Recruitment Event.

1-2 weeks after First Recruitment:

- 12. Repeat 7 9
- 13. Target age groups that haven't had a good turnout at first recruitment event
- 14. Second Recruitment event

Date determined by Pack:

- 15. Parent Orientation (can be combined with first Pack meeting)
- 16. First Pack meeting
- 17. Third Recruitment (if needed)
