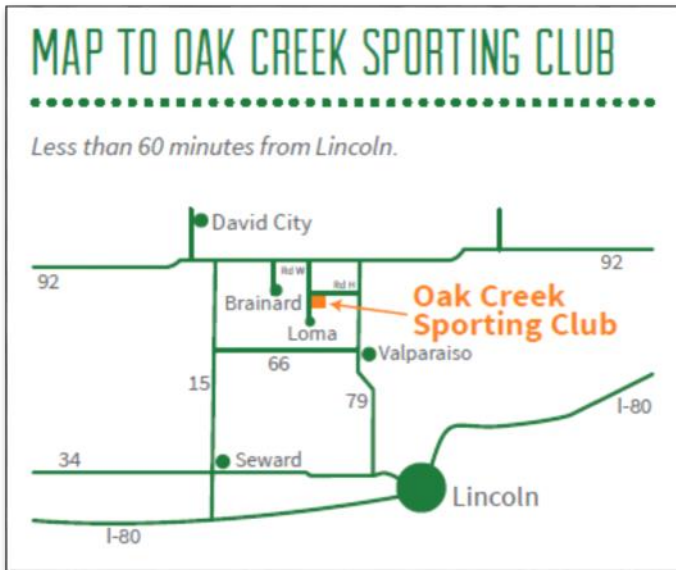

Driving Directions

From Lincoln

1. Drive north on Interstate I-180 until it turns into Highway 34 (Purple Heart Highway). (distance traveled will be about 4 miles from the end of Interstate 180).
2. Turn right at the Valparaiso exit onto NE-79 North. Drive 19 miles.
3. Turn left onto County Road H (by the Oak Creek Sporting Club sign). Drive 2 miles.
4. Turn left onto W Road.
5. Turn left immediately. Drive to the end of the Driveway.
