 - Fill out a flier request form and get those to Lee.
 - Flier requests are done through the Council Website by going to the menu, choosing membership and the scrolling down till you see <u>Online</u> recruitment flyer order form.
 - Don't worry about the quantity, Lee already has that information for your school and will get you plenty.
 - The goal is to get the fliers out the second week of school
 - If your school send their information home to parents digitally there is a digital option.
 - Let Lee Peterson know and he can get something to the school
 - This year in the membership materials there are stickers, temporary tattoos, buddy cards for inviting others to events, leaflets about scout life and other things.
 - If you have not already touched base with Lee please let him know what your packs plans are for open house and sign up night.
