Den Home set up is the weekend before camp.

Take Advantage of early check in days. June 11th and 12th from 2pm to 6 pm

Here are some Suggestions

- Bring a shade fly. If you don't have access to one let the Day Camp Staff know and we will do our best to find one for you.
- Create camp chairs out of 5-gallon buckets with lids to hold each scouts' personal items and keep them dry.
- Create a banner for your Pack decorated to promote Pack spirit.
- Plan meals, cold and hot. Your pack will be responsible for your Thursday evening meal.
- Friday afternoon is the camp fire so be prepared to share a skit, song, or run on.
- Make sure you have the correct number of volunteers for the number of scouts coming from your pack. If you need help let us know as early as possible so we can ask around for you.
- Make sure any Tigers coming from your pack have an approved partner if a parent is not available. Contact the camp staff for approval.
- Get your packs medical paper work together ahead of time. They will need Parts A & B and a copy of the
