Messages

- Training Item:
 - SLAT training went well so there are plans for more training like that in the future.
 - Youth Protection Training (YPT)
 - Live YPT training is scheduled for Oct 22 at the OEC.
 - Registration for the event is open on the council calendar.
 - This is open to all adults in the council whether they are registered or not.
 - Climbing Instructor Training
 - This training is scheduled for Nov 11 and 12.
 - Designed to train someone to help instruct groups that schedule a climb at the OEC.
 - The ask from the council is that one person from each unit is trained to assist when units schedule a climb.
 - Anyone 18+ can be an instructor
 - Getting trained and helping with climbs will help to earn the instructor free climbs.
- Safety Moment- Charcoal Safety
 - When you are doing your cooking and using charcoal do not use lighter fluid.
 - o For the best results and for optimal safety use a charcoal lighting chimney.
 - o If you do not have a charcoal chimney use approved starters.
 - There are commercially avaliable charcoal starters
 - As an alternative you can use newspaper, toilet paper rolls, egg cartons etc.
 - All lighting and handling of the charcoal should be done by an adult.
 - As with other fires don't leave the charcoal fire unattended and make sure it is out when it is done.
- Hot Topic <u>Journey to Excellence</u> (JTE)
 - This is the annual certification that a unit goes through, the time period considered is from January 1st through December 31st.
 - o Filling out the JTE form for your unit helps you evaluate how the unit did that year.
 - It can help the unit review how they did in the current year and then plan for improvement in the following vear.
 - Please have the JTE form completed and turned in no later than the January Roundtable.
 - If you are able to complete it before January, you can turn it in at any time.
 - Unit Commissioners should review the JTE form with the unit and can turn it in for them if the unit prefers.
