2022 Cornhusker Council Winter Camping Award

The Cornhusker Council Winter Camping Award is an incentive to promote winter camping. Winter camping should be an integral part of all Scout programs to ensure a variety of activities and also give scouts the opportunity to see if they are prepared for cold weather events. Time frame 1 October, 2021 through 31 March 2022 (6 months), Note: Spring Camporee may be in April, criteria as follows:

- 1. Complete the following to earn the Winter Camping Award during timeframe listed above.
 - a. Spend at least one night in a tent that you helped pitch on 3 different campouts. Fall & Spring Camporee and Klondike Derby may count (if tent camping).
 - b. Do 3 of the following events

- i. Participate in a three mile hike or 5 mile bike ride.
- ii. Build a fire using a striker and only the natural tinder, kindling, and fuel found in the surrounding camping area.
- iii. Plan and cook a complete meal that is approved by your Scout Master.
- iv. Participate in one hour of service projects your troop accomplishes.
- v. Advance one Rank (Scout), Attend a Round Table meeting (Adult)
- vi. Complete one of the following Merit badges(during time period):
 Backpacking, Camping, Cycling, Hiking, Snow Sports, Wilderness Survival.
- 2. The Troop Scribe/Patrol Leader is responsible for keeping records for the award and submitting them to the Scoutmaster to submit to the Trading Post. NOTE: one form for each Scout/Scouter
- 3. The Winter Camping Award Patch is a two part patch. The main patch only needs to be purchased once. The 2021 year dongle will need to be purchased and attached to the main patch. Future year dongles can be attached as they are earned.

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
