ELBERT K. FRETWELL OUTSTANDING EDUCATOR AWARD

The mission of the Boy Scouts of America is **to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law**. The Boy Scouts of America created the Elbert K. Fretwell Outstanding Educator Award to honor professionals in education who exemplify good character and inspire students to do likewise.

Dr. Fretwell, the namesake of this award, was an early leader of the Scouting movement in the United States and a leading scholar in education, focusing on the value of extra-curricular opportunity to improve education outcomes.
