Thank you for your hard work and dedication to serving our youth, particularly during these uncertain and everchanging times. Your commitment to providing Scouting experiences has given youth consistency and support throughout this pandemic. In our communities, we know that Scouting remains one of the most valuable investments we can make in our youth today, to help them become the leaders we will turn to tomorrow.

As we approach re-charter this year, please consider re-enrolling all youth that are currently on your Scout roster. With the uncertainty surrounding in-person meetings as well as school and extracurriculars, Unit Meetings have been different. To give All Scouts the opportunity to continue Scouting this winter and spring, we ask that you consider leaving them on your roster. We would like to partner with you to personally reengage them into your Scout unit. This short re-charter year (7 months) as we transition from calendar to program year presents an ideal time to give youth the opportunity to continue Scouting without paying for an entire year of membership fees. The cost to re-charter a youth for 7 months is \$38.50, the amount a Scout can earn by selling just \$150 in popcorn.

We recognize that your Scouting program probably looks a little different than it has in the past and want to ensure that our youth get the opportunity to experience Scouting in a more regular scenario. We also hope you will take advantage of our online Super Pack meetings, Troop resources, and upcoming events.

Thank you again for all you do – your work through Scouting provides outstanding Scouting experiences, that allow youth to grow in character, confidence, leadership, and hope.
