

Sign-Up for Scouting Information

- Conducting the best Sign-Up for Scouting event possible.
- Your recruiting event should accomplish two things:
 - Register the youth who have been recruited through school talks, back-to-school nights, and other events.
 - Recruit adult leaders (so important!)
- Your Pack should host at least two recruiting events.

- Work together with your district executive and use this guide to host a special Sign-Up for Scouting event
- Your Pack should have their first den meeting two weeks after the sign-up for Scouting event.



Big Things to Consider

Those who have been around Scouting for a while know why we put so much energy into recruitment. It's because everything we do to help serve youth starts with having youth in our Packs.

- Welcoming the Full Family to Scouting:
- The Charter Organization needs to support the decision.
- The Pack should set goals for both the number of boys, and girls to recruit to make sure we are serving the whole school.
- Follow the Council Recruitment Plan (the booklet you are holding).
- Starting new dens with a minimum of 6 youth so they can be successful.
